The roll was called and a quorum was determined.

Mayor Nelson asked the council to consider the tentative millage rate of 7.00 mills. Mr. Tomlinson stated the council had considered the new budget and decrease from 7.25 to 7.00 mills which will give us a surplus end of year of \$6,800.00. There was no discussion from the council.

Mayor Nelson closed the special council meeting and opened the public hearing for the tentative millage rate at 7.0 mills which represents a 7.2365 % increase over the rolled back rate of 6.5276 mills. Mr. Swartz read the resolution by title only adopting a proposed millage rate of 7.0 for the Village's general operating fund for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022, and ending September 30, 2023. There were no public comments. Motion made by Mr. Hodgson and seconded by Mrs. Bryan to approve the tentative millage rate of 7.0 mills for the 2022-2023 budget year. The roll was called and the motion passed unanimously. Public hearing was closed.

Mayor Nelson opened the public hearing for adopting a tentative budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023. Mr. Swartz read the resolution by title only adopting a tentative budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023. Determining and fixing the amounts necessary to carry on the government of the village for the ensuing year. There were no public comment. Motion made by Mr. Volkert and seconded by Mr. Hodgson to approve the tentative budget for the 2022-2023 budget year. The roll was called and the motion passed unanimously. The final budget hearing and September council meeting will be held on Wednesday, September 21, 2022 at 5:01 p.m. Public hearing was closed.
